- WHERE:** Bonita High School Sports Complex and local fields as needed. Most fields at a single location!
- WHEN:** Memorial Day Weekend, May 23<sup>rd</sup> - 24th, 2009; No Rain Dates.
- WHO:** Divisions U19, U16, U14 (11v11), U12 (9v9) and U10 (7v7) boys and girls (AYSO registered and played Fall, 2008); No Coed.
- BIRTHDAY CUTOFF:** July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008
- ENTRY FEES:** **\$350.00 (U10) or \$425.00 (U12-U19) plus \$200.00 Referee Deposit. Only Region Checks will be accepted.**
- The total amount of **\$550.00 for U10 or \$625 for U12-U19** is due with your completed registration package; **one Region check for both the registration fee and referee deposit is preferred.** The amount of **\$200.00** for the **referee deposit** will be refunded in full if a qualified 3-person referee team is submitted and officiates three (3) complete games (or two games and a scheduled stand-by period) on behalf of your team. **All Referee teams must be capable of doing games at or above the age level of the team they represent.**
- REFUNDS:** The entry fee will be refunded to you in full within 48 hours if your team is not accepted into this tournament. Full refunds will be given within 48 hours to teams that withdraw prior to 30 days before the tournament. Teams that withdraw less than 30 days before the tournament will receive a full refund if a replacement team can be found. If the tournament gets cancelled, teams will get a full refund.
- COMPETITION:** All teams will play a minimum of 3 games unless there is a no-show or forfeit.
- AWARDS:** All players will receive a tournament pin; coaches will receive pins, a program and a T-Shirt.

**Coach, when submitting your registration please keep in mind the following Great Western Shoot Out Guidelines:**

1. All Rosters must conform to standard AYSO age regulations. We prefer eayso rosters.
2. All teams should be registered with the tournament by **April 23rd, 2009**.
3. All rosters must be completed entirely and certified by the Regional Commissioner; eayso rosters are preferred.
4. Rosters will be limited to a maximum of 10 players for U10, 14 players for U12, 15 players for U14, and 18 players for U16 & U19. Each team will be allowed a maximum of two coaches. Coach Badges (with picture I.D.) will be issued at Team Check-in and must be relinquished upon request.
5. Any registered team selected for participation that elects not to participate after thirty (30) days before the Tournament, is subject to forfeiture of the registration fee.
6. Age groups for girls and boys to participate include:
  - Under 10 (U10) years of age
  - Under 12 (U12) years of age
  - Under 14 (U14) years of age
  - Under 16 (U16) years of age
  - Under 19 (U19) years of age
7. Absolutely no roster changes will be accepted on the day of the tournament. Roster changes can be made in advance by submitting the changes in writing, with your regional commissioner's signature, prior to **May 9th, 2009**.
8. Falsifying eligibility of player(s) will result in the team's expulsion from the tournament and all games forfeited. The respective Regional Commissioner will be notified of the infraction.
9. All coaches will be responsible to have present at the tournament the original AYSO player registration form, or a copy with an original signature and date.
10. Referee Deposits for eligible teams will be returned to the region within fourteen (14) days of tournament conclusion.
11. **No dogs allowed at any of the fields. No smoking allowed at any of the fields.**
12. If weather conditions force cancellation of this tournament, all fees will be returned except money for pre-ordered items. These items will be distributed to teams.
13. All communications will be conducted with the head coach or designated team contact.

**Rules and Regulations**

- RULES:** This tournament shall follow the laws and decisions of FIFA as adapted and amended for AYSO. The tournament directors will have jurisdiction over all games played. Infractions of tournament rules shall constitute the only areas of dispute. The tournament directors or his/her designees shall resolve all disputes immediately. **Any participant receiving a red card for violent misconduct or abusive language shall be suspended from the tournament. Any participant receiving a Red card for actions other than the above shall be suspended for the balance of that game, the team's next official game and the shootouts that may follow those games. In addition, standings points deductions as outlined herein shall be applied.** Any Red Cards will be reported to the Regional Commissioner. A player sent from the field must be accompanied by a Safe Haven certified volunteer or his/her parents. There will be no protesting of Red cards. The following rules are intended specifically for this tournament ONLY!
- The Great Western Shootout is sanctioned as an AYSO Invitational Tournament (AYSO teams only). **The Tournament Director may disqualify any team, at any point of the tournament, if a team refuses to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Tournament. Any situation not covered by these rules and regulations revert to AYSO Section and National Rules and Regulations.**
- PLAYERS/TEAMS ELIGIBILITY:** Players on participating teams must have played in an AYSO region during the 2008 Fall season. Rosters must be verified and approved by each player's Regional Commissioner. Teams are allowed to have up to three (3) guest players from another region provided every guest player has played for at least half their region's Fall season and has a signed guest player form or guest player roster giving approval to participate from their Regional Commissioner. **Regional Commissioner from guest player region must sign Team Roster or included Guest Player Form.**

Divisions U14 will play 11 aside and have a limit of 15 players per team. U12 will play 9 v 9 and have a limit of 14 players per team. U10 will play 7v7 and there will be a limit of 10 players per team. Divisions U16 and U19 will play 11 aside and have a limit of 18 players per team. No Coed Divisions allowed. **All players must play at least half of each game.** Violation of these two player rules opens a team up to protest and renders them subject to forfeiture of game and possible disqualification at the discretion of the Director.

There will be one (1) mandatory check-in prior to the first game played by each team at the 'Check-in Tent'.

- Teams should check in 1 hour before their first game at the registration tent, where both Coaches will be issued Picture I.D. Badges.
- At that time, the coach will present five (5) filled-in GWS game cards with players in numeric order and medical release forms with original wet ink signatures for the players.
- The players will be asked identifying questions.
- Any player who was not present for initial check-in is required to be presented at the 'check-in tent' by the coach before play is allowed.
- Absolutely no roster changes will be accepted on the day of the tournament. Roster changes should be made in advance by submitting the changes in writing, with your regional commissioner's signature, prior to **May 9th, 2009.**

Falsifying eligibility of player(s) will result in the team's expulsion from the tournament and all games forfeited. The respective Regional Commissioner will be notified of the infraction.

**Teams discovered with an ineligible player or players shall be disqualified from further competition. Previous matches played by the disqualified team will be recorded as a 1-0 win for the opposing team, regardless of the initial result.**

All coaches will be responsible to have present at the tournament the original AYSO player registration form, or a copy with an original signature and date.

All rosters must conform to the player's birthdays as of July 31, 2008 and must be signed by the Regional Commissioner. We prefer easyo rosters.

- TOURNAMENT FORMAT:** Each age division will be bracketed into playing pools. Each team will play a minimum of three (3) preliminary play games within their respective pools (cross pool play may be necessary depending on the number of teams in the brackets). If a team fails to show for their game, a forfeit will be awarded to the remaining team. Teams will advance from qualifying pools based on pool play standings points. Where cross-pool play is established, highest overall points will determine which team advances. Where uneven pools exist, a multiplier shall be applied to determine the best 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- GAME FORMAT:** Each qualifying pool game will consist of twenty, twenty-five or thirty minute halves (depending on the age division) with a five-minute half time. There will be a running clock during the match including substitutions. There will be no time added on for injuries or time wasted in qualifying rounds. Championship game durations are indicated below:
- DURATION OF PLAY:** Game duration shall be as follows:

Division	Pool Play	Championship Play
U-10	20 minute half	20 minute half
U-12	20 minute half	25 minute half
U-14	25 minute half	30 minute half
U-16, U-19	30 minute half	35 minute half

- SUBSTITUTIONS:** For lower age divisions (U10 through U14), substitution is permitted approximately midway through the first half, and approximately midway through the second half. Additionally, substitutions may be made at half time and at the start of any overtime periods in accordance with AYSO National Rules and Regulations. Upper Division play (U16 and U19) shall be monitored substitutions on any stoppage at the Referees discretion, see attached form.
- SEMI-FINAL AND CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL GAMES** ending in a tie will have two full overtime periods of five minutes in length with teams changing field direction after the first five-minute period. If still tied after overtime play, the game shall be decided by kicks from the penalty mark. Each team will have up to 5 alternating kicks each and the best of 5 shall be declared the winner. If the game is still tied after 5 kicks have been taken by each team, then each team will take additional kicks until one team scores and the other team fails to score. Each kick must be taken by a different player, and every player must have taken a kick before any player takes a second kick.

9. **STANDINGS:** Standings for qualifying round games will be determined based on the following point system:

WIN	= 6 points
TIE	= 3 points
LOSS	= 0 points
GOAL	= 1 point (one point per goal scored up to a maximum of 3 per game, win or lose)
SHUTOUT	= 1 point (for an <u>earned</u> shutout, including a 0-0 tie)
SEND OFF	= -2 points (deducted for any player, coach OR spectator)
FORFEIT	= 8 points (scored as a 2-0 win, no shutout points as it is not an "earned" shutout)

Winners of ties in standings will be determined as follows:

- Head to head competition
- Goals allowed (fewest number advances)
- Shoot Out Head to Head result. If no head to head match-up then the total number of Shootout wins will apply.
- Shoot Out goals. Total number of goals scored in the shoot out competition.

10. **Field of Play:** Set up will be done by the first teams to play each morning. Take down will be done by the last teams to play. **Teams from all games shall remain on opposite sides of the field of play. The Home Team will have the North or East side of the field to occupy. The Home Team shall kick off to start the match and Visitors shall choose initial direction of play (no coin toss required).**
11. **Coaches and Spectators:** Shall encourage clean play and good sportsmanship at all times and shall refrain from negative comments and/or complaints about referees or the opposing teams players / coaches. Unsportsmanlike conduct could result in a caution or removal from the field of play. **Coaches shall control their spectators and enforce the NO DOGS and NO SMOKING requirements while they are on an AYSO or school field. Each team will be allowed a maximum of two coaches which must be Safe Haven Certified and possess GWS Picture I.D. Badges.**
12. **Medical Emergencies:** Emergency 911 will be utilized for all injuries requiring professional medical assistance. First aid supplies will be on site at the Tournament. Each venue will be staffed with an emergency manager; and all injuries must be reported to the emergency manager. First aid information, local emergency numbers and evacuation procedures will be posted at all venues. First aid kits will be available at all venues.
13. **Refunds:** If the tournament is cancelled, teams will get a full refund. If unforeseen events require early termination of the tournament (less than the 3 game guarantee), a pro-rated refund will be given, less money for items pre-purchased for the teams. If the 3 game guarantee has been met, no refund will be given. Refunded fees will be sent to the Regional Commissioner within 30 days of the tournament. No checks will be mailed to coaches, referees or parents. **Any team or teams that are ejected from the tournament will forfeit their Entry Fee and Referee Deposits.** The entry fee will be refunded to you in full if your team is not accepted into this tournament. Full refunds will be given within 48 hours to teams that withdraw prior to 30 days before the tournament. Teams that withdraw less than 30 days before the tournament will receive a full refund if a replacement team can be found. Any registered team selected for participation that elects not to participate after notification is subject to forfeiture of the registration fee. Referee Deposits for eligible teams will be returned to the region within fourteen (14) days of tournament conclusion.
14. **Player Uniforms:** Each player on the team shall wear a jersey in accordance with AYSO National Rules and Regulations, including the AYSO logo, with a different number (Goalkeeper may have a different jersey, AYSO Logo not required). The player may not exchange it with another player for the duration of the game. At the customary handshake after the game, all players MUST be wearing their jerseys.
15. **Line-up Cards:** Only GWS game line-up cards, previously approved and marked at team check-in, shall be presented to the Referee / Field Marshall prior to the start of each game. The game cards shall include all registered players, present or not. An explanation for those players who are not in attendance at the game shall be given. In addition, **Upper Division Time Sheets (U16/U19) are available from our website / Tournament Page.**
16. **Safety Guidelines:**
- a. All players must wear shin guards at all times during the game. They must be completely covered inside the sock for the duration of the game
  - b. No jewelry, splints or casts of any kind will be allowed.
  - c. Knee braces – AYSO will not prohibit the use of knee braces by players in AYSO events and programs, provided that the brace is adequately covered and padded in the judgment of the referee, so as to eliminate the possibility of its causing injury to the other players on the field of play.
  - d. No dogs and no smoking allowed on any Tournament Field.

17. **Shootout Competition:**

This is a separate competition from the Great Western Shoot Out and will take place regardless of the outcome of the match. (Shootout results may be used to break ties in the regular GWS Tournament)

The Shootout Competition format shall be that all teams, after their regularly scheduled pool play games, should proceed to the nearest designated shootout goal and participate in the penalty kick portion of the tournament. The Shootouts shall proceed in a normal manner EXCEPT that each team shall take a MINIMUM of five (5) penalty shots and if still tied after five alternating kicks, then additional kicks will be taken on a sudden death basis. Each player must take a kick before another player can take a second kick. At least five kicks must be taken even if a team is well ahead in the shoot out. (Total goals scored will be used in the event of ties.)

If a team fails to participate in the shoot out, then the opposing team will be awarded a win on a 5-0 basis.

Medals will be awarded to the team in each division that has the most shoot out wins. In the event of a tie the team with the most goals scored will be awarded the title. If goals scored still results in a tie, then the team with the least goals scored against them will be awarded the title. Where uneven pools are established, an additional shootout may be scheduled by the Tournament Committee to determine the overall winner. See Shoot Out Summary Sheet.

**Referee Plan**

Each team participating in the tournament must provide at least one team of AYSO certified and trained referees (including Safe Haven Certification), Regional patch level or greater. A team of referees is defined as three AYSO-qualified individuals versed in the Laws of the Game, including current law changes and capable of applying the laws according to the spirit of the game capable of Officiating games at the division level of the team they represent or higher.

The referee deposit is **\$200.00**. This deposit will be refunded in full if a qualified 3-person referee team is submitted and officiates three (3) complete games or two (2) complete games and one scheduled Stand-by period on behalf of your team.

Proper referee attire as defined by FIFA is required.

All referees must be Safe Haven certified and AYSO Trained.

The referees must be able to officiate the division level that they represent or higher.

The referee assignments may extend outside the division they represent.

As much as possible, neutral referee teams will be assigned to each game. However, due to scheduling conflicts or no-shows, some games may be officiated by referees from one of the participating team's Region.

The Great Western Shoot Out will use the diagonal system of control (one referee and two assistant referees).

Supplemental referee teams will be provided from the hosting region, or volunteer teams from other regions, to cover vacancies or lack of qualified referee teams.

Each referee team should expect to officiate at least three games. If complied with, the referee deposit will be refunded within 14 days of tournament completion. Each team of referees must check-in at the referee station 30 minutes before and immediately after each game to receive full credit. Late check-in prior to any game may result in forfeiture of the referee deposit.

Referee teams may be assigned a "stand-by" assignment for a particular time slot. This is a required assignment and subject to deposit-refund determination. "Stand-by" referees must check-in at the referee station in the same manner as an actual game assignment and remain there for a two hour period until it is verified that all games are covered. The Great Western Shoot Out Staff highly discourages coaches from also serving as the referee for the team. In many cases, the referee team will be assigned either to the match directly prior or directly following the team's match, leaving a coach little time to prepare for either assignment. The coach should recruit other parent volunteers to serve as referees.

Referees must file a formal written report for red cards, ejections, and spectator or coach misconduct.

Participating referees will be instructed to exercise control of the game to maintain safety and good sportsmanship from the players, coaches and spectators. Trifling matters may not be called if it is fair and good sportsmanship is prevalent. The referee will be expected to uphold the Laws of the game, as well as to ensure compliance with all tournament rules and guidelines. Above all, it is the referee's goal to ensure the game is safe, fair and fun for all participants!

Where these guidelines are complied with, the referee deposit will be refunded within 14 days of the tournament completion.

To be eligible for the referee deposit refund, the referee registration forms must be received by the Tournament Committee no later than April 18th, along with other registration materials (Roster, Application and Check)

This is a separate competition from the Great Western Shoot Out.  
(Shootout results may be used to break ties in the regular GWS Tournament)

1. There will be a shoot out after every game in pool play, regardless of the outcome of the game.
2. Goals for the shoot out will be set up near the playing fields. Please move to the appropriate goal after each pool game. This will help to keep the tournament on schedule.
3. Each team must take a minimum of five (5) alternating kicks. If both teams are tied after five kicks, then additional kicks will be taken on a sudden death basis. Each player must take a kick before another player can take a second kick. All kicks must be taken even if a team is well ahead in the shoot out. (Total goals scored will be used in the event of ties.)
4. If a team fails to participate in the shoot out, then the opposing team will be awarded a win on a 5-0 basis.
5. Medals will be awarded to the team in each division that has the most shoot out wins. In the event of a tie the team with the most goals scored will be awarded the title. If goals scored still results in tie then the team with the least goals scored against them will be awarded the title. Where uneven pools are established, an additional shootout may be scheduled by the Tournament Committee to determine the overall winner.
