

### **Basic Referee Instructor Grade Recertification**

- **Number of courses per year**  
You must teach a full instructional load, consisting of a minimum of two (2) classes, in at least one (1) qualifying referee instructional activity.
- **Basic Grade Instructional Activities**  
To qualify by teaching in one of these activities, you must serve as
  - lead or co-instructor in  
Assistant Referee Training Course (ARTC, formerly the LTC)  
Regional Referee Course (RRC),  
Referee Assessor Course (RAC), or  
Youth Referee Training Event
  - OR co-instructor in  
Basic Referee Administrator Training (BRAT) when course is authorized by your SRA,  
Area Referee Course (ARC), or  
Section Referee Course (SRC)

### **Intermediate Referee Instructor Grade Recertification**

- **Number of courses per year**  
You must teach a full instructional load, consisting of a minimum of two (2) classes, in at least three (3) separate qualifying referee instructional activities.
- **Intermediate Grade Specific Instructional Activities**  
One of your annual instructional activities must be to teach in at least one (1) higher level course. These include serving as
  - lead or co-instructor in  
Area Referee Course (ARC),  
Section Referee Course (SRC), or  
Referee Assessor Course (lead instructor only);
  - OR co-instructor, when authorized by SDI, in  
National Assessor Course, (NAC),  
National 2 Referee Course (N2RC),  
National 1 Referee Course (N1RC), or  
Basic Referee Instructor Program (BRIP).
- **Other Qualifying Activities**  
The other two (2) of your qualifying referee instructional activities may come from the list above or from these additional items.  
Assistant Referee Training Course (ARTC),  
Regional Referee Course (RRC),  
Youth Referee Training Event,  
Referee Assessor Course (RAC), (co-instructor),  
Section Meeting Workshop (lead or co-instructor, not assistant),  
Basic Referee Administrator Training (BRAT),  
Referee In-service Training, or  
Referee Instructor In-service Training (with prior approval of the SDI).

### **Advanced Referee Instructor Grade Recertification**

- **Number of courses per year**  
You must teach a full instructional load, consisting of a minimum of two (2) classes, in at least three (3) separate qualifying referee instructional activities.
- **Advanced Grade Specific Instructional Activities**  
One of your annual instructional activities must be to perform in at least one (1) of AYSO's most demanding instructional duties. These include serving as
  - lead instructor in  
Section Referee Course (SRC),  
National Assessor Course (NAC), or  
Basic Referee Administrator Training (BRAT);
  - OR lead or co-instructor in  
National 2 Referee Course (N2RC) (lead authorized by SDI),  
National 1 Referee Course (N1RC) (lead authorized by NDI),  
Basic Referee Instructor Program (BRIP) (lead authorized by SDI and NDI), or  
Advanced Referee Instructor Program (ARIP) (lead authorized by NDI);
  - OR approved mentor in  
Intermediate Referee Instructor Program (IRIP);
  - OR program developer as requested by the NDI.
- **Other Qualifying Activities**  
The other two (2) of your qualifying referee instructional activities may come from the list above or from these additional items.  
Assistant Referee Training Course (ARTC),  
Regional Referee Course (RRC),  
Youth Referee Training Event,  
Area Referee Course (ARC),  
Section Referee Course (SRC) (co-instructor),  
Referee Assessor Course (RAC),  
National Assessor Course (NAC) (co-instructor),  
Section Meeting Workshop (lead or co-instructor, not assistant),  
Basic Referee Administrator Training (BRAT) (co-instructor),  
Referee In-service Training, or  
Referee Instructor In-service Training (with prior approval of the SDI).
